The Department hereby declares the firm commitment of its executives and officials to uphold the highest standards of integrity through the implementation of a strict "No Gift Policy." Under this policy, no official within the Department shall accept any gifts or gratuities of any kind in relation to their official duties, whether before, during, or after their performance. Executives and supervisors at all levels are required to lead by example, ensuring that their conduct reflects this policy and that they diligently oversee their subordinates to maintain proper conduct and consistently adhere to the highest ethical standards at all times.

This policy is hereby announced and shall be strictly observed by all.
