



Announcement of the Department of Fisheries

Subject: Non-Acceptance of Gifts and Gratuities in the Performance of Official Duties (No Gift Policy)
for the Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

The Department of Fisheries is committed to cultivating a culture of integrity within the organization; conducting its operations in accordance with the principles of good governance; promoting transparency; upholding honesty; and ensuring accountability in the execution of its duties, with the objective of establishing and maintaining public trust and confidence.

Therefore, it is hereby declared as the official policy that the Department of Fisheries shall operate as an agency in which all its officials refrain from accepting any gifts or gratuities, whether offered before, during, or after the performance of their duties, and on any occasion or festival, in order to prevent corruption and misconduct both now and in the future. This measure also aims to instill positive attitudes and ethical values in performing duties with integrity and transparency. Executives and supervisors at all levels shall set a good example through full compliance with applicable laws and regulations, and shall be responsible for ensuring that all subordinate officials conduct themselves appropriately.
